SUBJECT: LIFTING OF DEFINITIVE SAFEGUARD MEASURE ON IMPORTED TESTLINER BOARD

In a letter dated July 21, 2020, Atty. Luis M. Catibayan, Director, DTI, requested the Bureau to issue the relevant order to stop the collection of definitive general safeguard duty for importation of Testliner Board from various countries classified under AHTN Codes 4805.2400, 4805.2510 and 4805.2590.

Considering that DTI Order dated August 19, 2016, circularized under CMC No.125-2016, provides that the last year of the imposition of the definitive safeguard measure for imported Testliner Board under the above AHTN codes is from 18 June 2019 to 20 June 2020, the same is hereby ordered lifted.
