This Department has been invited by the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) to nominate candidates to the above-mentioned leadership program.

The SDGs Global Leadership Program aims to develop high level human resources who will contribute to appropriate policy decision and its implementation for tackling political and developmental issues in respective fields. It will offer scholarships for Master's degree course, Ph.D. course and combined Master's and Ph.D. to partner Japanese Universities.

Candidate applicants must satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Current Duties: young or middle government official, prospective academics, personnel from private institutions who are expected to contribute policy formulation or its implementation for tackling sustainable developmental issues in respective fields.
- 2. Nationality: Citizen of the above countries eligible for Japan's ODA.
- 3. Age: Less than forty (40) years old in principle (as of April 1st 2021).
- 4. Educational Background: Holds a Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree.
- 5. Language: Adequate English skills both in written and oral communication to complete the master's and/or Ph.D. courses such as: TOEFL iBT: 80, IELTS: 6.5.
- 6. Others: Candidate applicants must not be receiving nor planning to receive another scholarship during the program.

Under the JICA Long-term Trainee Allowance standards, JICA will cover expenses and allowance to participants accepted for the program including tuition, living allowance, airfare, outfit allowance, moving allowance and research support expenses.
