SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO SEC. 3.1 (ISSUANCE OF ALERT ORDERS) OF CMO 07-2018 ON "REVISED RULES FOR THE ELECTRONIC/MANUAL ISSUANCE AND LIFTING OF ALERT ORDERS AT ALL PORTS OF ENTRY"
Pursuant to Section 1111, par. 7, of Republic Act No. 10863 otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), Sec.3.1, par. 2 of CMO 07-2018 is hereby amended to read as follows:
Sec. 3.1 Issuance of Alert Orders.
X X X X
Alert Orders shall be <u>validated</u> , dated, assigned a unique reference number in series, <u>and monitored by the Alert Order Clearing House Desk, under the Deputy</u>
Commissioner, Intelligence Group, which shall be the basis for reporting to and

monitoring by the Commissioner and the Secretary of Finance. <u>Hence, all alert orders for issuance shall be coursed thru the Alert Order Clearing House Desk.</u>

All other provisions of CMO 07-2018 which are not in conflict and inconsistent

This Order shall take effect immediately.

with this CMO shall remain valid and in effect.
