Logistics, the request of Port-Net Inc., for the appointment/deployment of wharfinger, and the opposition of the Association of Off-Dock Container Yard and/or Container Freight Station (ACOP) docketed as Control No. POCD 19-01-022 and 25, there is hereby created a Technical Working Committee composed of the Deputy Commissioner of AOCG or his duly authorized representative as Chairman, and the District/Port Collectors of Port of Manila and Manila International Container Port (MICP) or their duly authorized representatives and a representative from the Office of the Commissioner (OCOM) as Members, tasked to completely determine the factual issue as to the Aggregate Capacity Utilization (ACU) of the existing ODCY/CFS that relates to the Certificate of Authority (COA) issued to Port Net Logistics, Inc., dated 9 November 2016.
