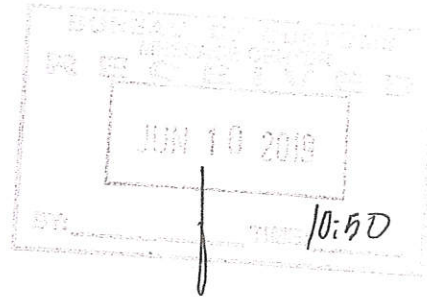

We would appreciate if you could provide the following:

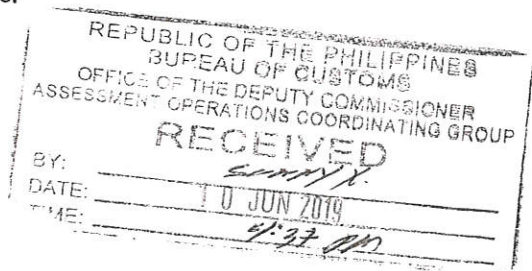
- country/consignee/type of imports or waste,
