ISSUED SPECIAL LANDING PERMIT (SLP)

Pursuant to Sections 1220 and 1224 of R.A. 10863, otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), aircraft arriving in the Philippines from any foreign port or place which shall make its first landing at a non-international port of entry, including its departure therefrom should first obtain permission or clearance from the Bureau of Customs' Commissioner.

In relation thereto, the designated non-international airport covered by the issued Special Landing Permit is hereby directed to comply with the required submission of after operations report with pictures showing that upon arrival and before departure such aircraft was boarded by a customs officer. Submission to the Office of the Commissioner should be made within five (5) days from the Arrival and Entry of Aircraft and its Departure from said airport of entry. An advance copy of the report should be submitted to boc.ocom@customs.gov.ph.
