CUSTOMS MEMOR UDUM ORDER NO. 3 - 90

Subject CREATION OF A WAREHOUSING COMMITTEE

In order to (fectively control and supervise the operations of Customs Bonded Warehouse hereby created a Warehousing Committee composed of the following officials/employees:

Specifically the Committee shall have the following duties and functions:

- 1. Intensity monitoring of bonded shipments and institute ways and means to simplify material accounting.
- Identif problems and problem areas in the day-to-day operations of CBWs and introduce remedial solutions.
- 3. Determine accounts of CBW operators in coordination with the Collect a Service, Liquidation & Billing Division, Bonds Division and the Warehousing Accounts Committee and institu! ways and means to collect due accounts

- 4. Prepare the systems and the procedures as well as determine the requirements in the implementation of Open Bonded Warehouse scheme and in the conversion of "closed" bonded warehouses into "open bonded warehouses;
- 5. Study the system and procedure relative to approval of applications to operate CBWs, to close CBWs, to extend storage of bonde is shipments and other present practices with the end in view at simplifying the procedure and minimizing documentary requirements:
- Study the possibility of harmonizing the GTEB and EOI rules and regulations as they relate to the Customs rules and regulations on matter involving the garment and other related manufacturing industries;
- 7. Conductively of all Customs rules, regulations, systems and procedures and other applicable instructions aimed at integrating and simplifying the same; and
- 8. Render periodic reports and carry out instructions of the Corner stoner of Customs.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall last until revoked.
