CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDES NO. 46-90

SUBJECT: Supplement To CHO No. 140-88,
As Amended BY CHO No. 34-89,
On Importations by Export
Processing Zone Registered
Enterprises

CMO No. 140-88, as amended by CHO No. 34-89, is hereby supplemented as follows:

- SECTION 1. For uniformity, proper monitoring and control and in order to fully protest the interests of the government, all importations intended for the Export Processing Zone Registered Enterprises (EZRES) shall be covered by warehousing entry which shall be filed at the Port of Destination and shall be liquidated within the period allowed by Law.
- SECTION 2. In order to expedite the processing of EXRE importations by Custome-EXRE, the Chief of the Intry Processing Division at the Port of Discharge shall provide Custome-ECDU with the excerpts of the Inward Foreign Manifest covering the EXRE importations.
- SECTION 3. Any Customs Memorandum Order, Memorandum Circular inconsistent herewith, is deemed repealed and/or modified accordingly.
- SECTION 4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
