- 1.0 The Philippine Public Safety College (PPSC) is launching in April 2016 the new and enhanced Master in Public Administration (MPSA) a one year scholarship program for highly qualified senior executives and uniformed personnel in the public safety and security sector.

- 3.0 Applicants to the Master in Public Safety Administration (MPSA) Program must meet the following basic requirements:

For the Non-Uniformed Government Personnel:

- Possess a bachelor's degree.
- Hold a position with salary grade 20 or its equivalent.
- At least ten (10) years of service in government (for appointed officials).
- Not less than 35 years old, but not more than 55 years old upon admission.
- Nominated by the Secretary of the Department or Head of the Agency.
- Submit the following documents:
 - ✓ NSO authenticated Birth Certificate.
 - ✓ Endorsement letter from respective agencies.
 - ✓ Original Transcript of Records.
 - ✓ Certified true copy of Diploma/s.
 - ✓ Latest Appointment Paper.
 - ✓ Latest Performance Evaluation Report (1 year).
 - ✓ Service Record.
 - ✓ Certificate/s of training/seminars attended.
 - ✓ Medical certificate from a military or government hospital.
 - Contract of Commitment by the nominating Department Secretary or Head of Agency to fully support financially the foreign travel and thesis requirements.
