The BOPIR shall review and/or prepare decisions and resolutions in administrative disciplinary cases involving the following:

- 1. Organic personnel of the DOF;
- 2. Local Treasurers and Assistant Treasurers;
- 3. Personnel of Attached Bureaus and Agencies where the penalty involved is removal from service; and
- 4. Appealed cases of personnel of Attached Bureaus and Agencies where the penalty is suspension for more than thirty (30) days or fine equivalent to thirty (30) days salary.

The BOPIR shall have the power to conduct fact-finding investigations or clarificatory hearings to determine the truth in disciplinary cases under its review or consideration.

Finally, the BOPIR shall have the authority to issue rules and regulations that will govern the exercise of its functions.
