Several reports have reached the Office of the Commissioner that unscrupulous AMO personnel have been using the threat of suspension or cancellation of accreditation of importer or broker, citing CMO 11-2014, to harass, intimidate and extort from said importers and brokers.

Pending verification of these harassment and extortion complaints from numerous importers and brokers, it is hereby ordered that <u>only</u> the Commissioner of Customs, or his authorized representative/s, can order the suspension and/or cancellation of registration of importers and brokers, in accordance with existing regulations.

The OIC-Deputy Commissioner, MISTG is hereby directed to immediately cancel the password/s of all AMO personnel which they use to gain access to the E2m system.
