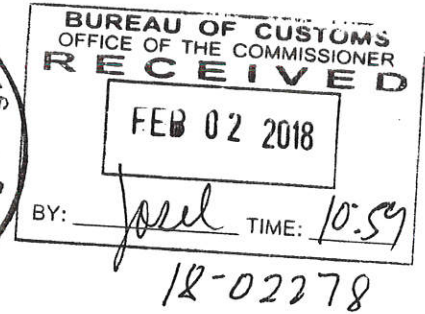

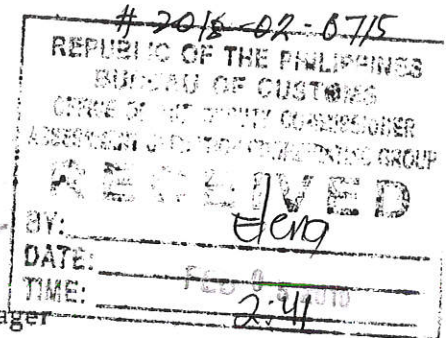
Your prompt response to this humble request shall immensely contribute in the efforts to mitigate the impacts of the present Mayon Volcano crisis.

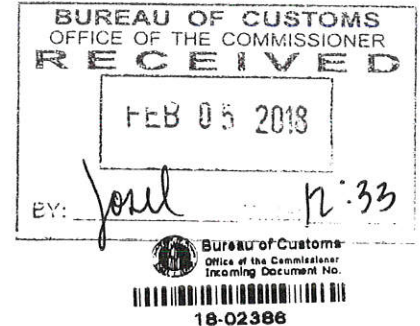
