In view of the requirement by the National Coast Watch Council Secretariat (NCWCS) as per attached hereto letter ("Annex A") of Mr. Jose Luis M. Alano, Executive Director, NCWCS on the information necessary to ensure national security, all Piers Inspection Division (PID), Port Operations Division (POD) or equivalent offices in all seaports and sub-seaports of the Bureau of Customs.

Dear COMMISSIONER LAPEÑA:

This has reference to the request of the Benline Philippines Agencies Incorporated (BAPI) for the issuance of Special Permit on the utilization of the RV Northern Endeavor for the conduct of the Jupiter cable route survey at the vicinity off Daet, Camarines Norte.

In the inter-agency meetings that were conducted to look into the matter, the concerned agencies agreed to implement the standing instructions of the NSA on the case of the EGS Surveyor, which are as follows:

- For BAPI to submit vessel crew and passenger data, survey plan, and results of the bathymetric survey;
- For concerned agencies to conduct customs, immigration, quarantine, and port state control inspections; and
- For concerned agencies to assign personnel to board the vessel as observers.

In view thereof, request that the results of the conducted inspection on the vessel be provided to this Office for reference purposes.
