

Under Customs Administrative Order No. 09-2008 entitled Creation of a Permanent Intellectual Property Rights Division (IPRD) in the Bureau of Customs, the IPRD is mandated, among others, to investigate cases involving IPR violations, to make recommendations for prosecution of violations in relation to the Intellectual Property Code, to gather and manage ALL data relative to Intellectual Property Rights enforcement, and to coordinate all BOC enforcement activities relating to IPR matters.

In order to give effect to such mandates of the IPRD, you are hereby directed to submit every last Monday of every month to the IPRD a report, using the herein attached format **Annex "A"**, on all your IPR-related apprehensions, seizures, operations, incidents and accomplishments, implementation of Letter/s of Authority, segregations, forfeitures, abandonment, disposition and attaching thereto material supporting documents.
