
SUBJECT: **EXPIRATION OF THE IMPOSITION OF PROVISIONAL SAFEGUARD DUTY ON THE IMPORTED CLEAR FLOAT GLASS CLASSIFIED UNDER AHTN CODE 7005.29.90 AND BRONZE FLOAT GLASS UNDER AHTN CODE 7005.21.90 FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

With reference to the herein attached letter dated 20 September 2022, from Maria Guiza B. Lim, Director, Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the DTI is requesting the Bureau of Customs (BOC) to implement BOC-CMC No. 138-2017 in accordance with the DTI Order with Case No. 1-16 and Investigation No. AD-2016-Float Glass CN, specifically on the duration of the imposition of the definitive Anti-dumping duties.

The said Order imposed a definitive Anti-dumping duties on importation of clear float glass and bronze float glass from People's Republic of China for a period of five (5) years. Since DTI order took effect upon issuance of BOC-CMC No. 138-2017 on 06 September 2017, the same expired on 05 September 2022 being the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> year of the imposition period.

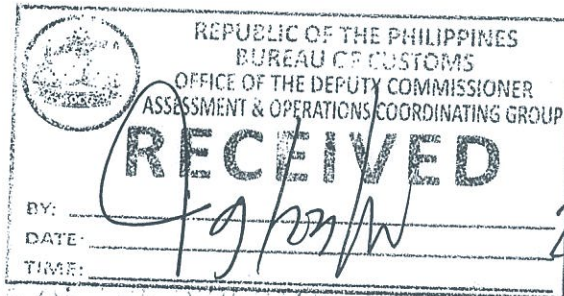

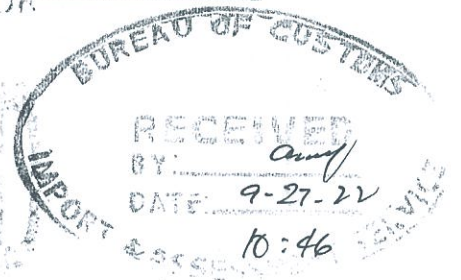
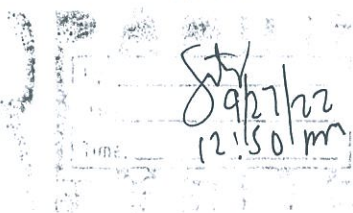
