Subject: Delegation of Signing/Approving Authority
in Administrative /Criminal Cases

In the interest of the service with the end in view of expediting action on all administrative/criminal cases submitted to the Commissioner of Customs for action, disposition or decision, the authority to act on such matters is hereby delegated to Deputy Commissioner LICERIO C. EVANGELISTA. However, in cases where the recommendation/disposition will result in the exoneration of the respondent/s or the dismissal of the cases, the matter should be referred first by Deputy Commissioner LICERIO C. EVANGELISTA to the Commissioner of Customs for clearance, citing the grounds for the recommendation.

A weekly report shall be submitted to the Commissioner of Customs on all cases acted upon by virtue of the delegated authority with the following information:

1. Name of Respondent/Accused
2. Nature of Charge
3. Brief statement of reasons for the action
4. Copy of the Disposition Form and decision, order, implementing indorsement, memorandum or letter as the case may be.

This Order, which shall take effect immediately until revoked, shall supersede CMO 90-92.
