The Accreditation Committee under CMO 30-91 that accredits importers availing of the EPRS System is hereby reconstituted whose functions shall include the accreditation of Garment Exporters exempting them from the SGS pre-shipment inspection pursuant to Section 5 of CMO 30-93.

The Committee shall have the following functions:

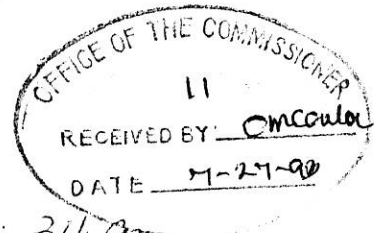
1. To evaluate application for certificate of accreditation under the EPRS and exemption from SGS pre-shipment inspection by garment exporters.
2. To receive and investigate information adverse to the application and/or consider evidence in opposition thereto.
3. *To insure that only meritorious cases are approved.*

This Order shall take effect upon approval by the Commissioner of Customs.
