CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER

NO. 2-2015

SUBJECT: Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty on Wheat Flour Imports from Turkey for a period of Five (5) years

Pursuant to Department Order No. 10 dated 17 November 2014 issued by the Department of Agriculture (DA) entitled "Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duty on Wheat Flour Imports From Turkey (AHTN 2012 1101.00.10) (Anti-Dumping Investigation No. 01-2014)" and the letter dated 17 November 2014 of the DA Secretary notifying the Department of Finance and the Bureau of Customs of the final decision to impose an anti-dumping duty on the said product, **all District Collectors shall collect the corresponding anti-dumping duty on the following exporters of wheat flour from Turkey for a period of five (5) years:**

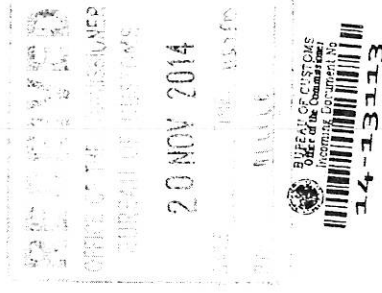

Dear Secretary Purisima:

This is to notify you that the Tariff Commission has concluded its formal investigation on the petition of Philippine Flour Millers, Inc. (PAFMIL) to impose an anti-dumping measure for imported wheat flour from Turkey (AHTN 2012 11001.00.10) on 11 November 2014. The Commission established that the threat of material injury to the local industry caused by the importation of dumped wheat flour from Turkey is imminent and thus ordered for the imposition of anti-dumping duties on the said product for a period of five (5) years.

Pursuant to RA 8752, upon receipt of the affirmative final determination by the Commission, we are hereby furnishing the Department of Finance (DOF) a copy of the Department Order for the imposition of anti-dumping duty on imported wheat flour from Turkey. We are also requesting DOF, thru Bureau of Customs (BOC), to impose the corresponding anti-dumping duty on the following exporters of wheat flour from Turkey for a period of 5 years:

Subject: **IMPOSITION OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTY ON WHEAT FLOUR IMPORTS
FROM TURKEY (AHTN 2012 1101.00.10)
(Anti-Dumping Investigation No. 01-2014)**

Pursuant to Republic Act 8752, referred to as the Anti-Dumping Act of 1999, and the affirmative final determination of the Tariff Commission on the anti-dumping protest filed by the Philippine Association of Flour Millers, Inc. against the importation of wheat flour (AHTN 2012 1101.00.10) from Turkey, the Department of Agriculture hereby requested the Department of Finance, through the Bureau of Customs, for the imposition of the corresponding anti-dumping duty on the following exporters from Turkey for a period of five (5) years:

Paragraph (g) of Section 18 of IRR to RA 8752 provides that "New foreign exporters who have not exported the dumped product to the Philippines during the POI may request for an accelerated review provided they are not related to any foreign exporter who is subject to the anti-dumping duty. The application must be submitted to the Commission in writing and must contain:

1. a description of the foreign exporter's product; and
2. the basis of the request.


No anti-dumping duty shall be imposed during the review. A provisional duty may be required to ensure that, in the case of an affirmative finding, the anti-dumping duty can be levied retroactively up to the date of the initiation of the review."

This Order shall take effect upon the issuance of the relevant Memorandum Order by the Bureau of Customs or 15 days after the publication of this Order in two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.

Let this Order be published in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and let individual notices be sent to all interested parties.
