CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM  
ORDER NO. 80-92

SUBJECT: NEW CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN FOR IMPORTS  
OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS INTO THE  
EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

Starting August 1, 1992, the EC Commission will strictly require the use of the new Certificate of Origin for imports of agricultural products that do not fall under the preferential tariff treatment of the EC-GSP scheme. EC customs authorities will not allow entry of shipments of agricultural products without the prescribed certificate. The GSP Form A shall continue to be used for products qualified for preferential treatment.

The expectation is that the form will have limited use so in order to meet the date requirement the exporters may be allowed to provide their own forms. Forms should not deviate from the sample form attached as to format, substance and size. The certificate shall be prepared in three copies; the original and a copy shall go to the exporter while the third copy shall be BOC file.
