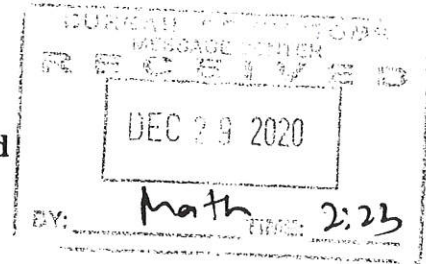

Subject : **Export of scrap metals is not regulated**

Dear Mr. Medina:

This has reference to your letter dated 4 December 2020, with IIS Tracking Reference No. CO-2020-036957, regarding your inquiry on the export of scrap metals (copper, aluminum, brass) to China for commercial use. Please be informed that the export of such materials is not covered by the permitting requirements of Republic Act (RA) 6969. Therefore an Export Clearance (EC) is not required. This Office only regulates and issues EC for the export of hazardous wastes pursuant to Chapter 10 of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) 2013-22 destined for recovery, treatment, and final disposal in relation to the Philippine obligation to the Basel Convention on the transboundary movements of hazardous wastes and their disposal.

In this regard, we interpose no objection to the proposed export.

We hope we have addressed your concern.
