



CERTIFICATION

TO: DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE

The Department of Energy (DOE) duly certifies that the trigger price levels for the suspension of the second tranche of TRAIN Law for petroleum products, i.e. "when the average Dubai crude oil price based on Mean of Platts Singapore (MOPS) for three (3) months prior to the scheduled increase of the month reaches or exceeds Eighty dollars (USD 80) per barrel", has not been reached.

The average MOPS price of Dubai crude in the international market for the last three months prior to January 2019, were US\$79.39 per barrel, US\$65.56 per barrel, and \$57.86 per barrel¹, respectively. As such, pursuant to Section 43 of R.A. No. 10963 (TRAIN Law), the second tranche of excise tax for petroleum shall be implemented effective 01 January 2019, subject to the full exhaustion of the per-depot inventory as of 31 December 2018.

This Certification is issued on 27 December 2018.
