RESPONSIBILITY OF MONITORING GREEN LANE ENTRIES

In furtherance of our commitment to facilitate trade, the Green Lane selectivity is now fully reactivated in the system. In relation to this, you are hereby directed to exercise the necessary vigilance in monitoring any irregularities or anomalies you will observe in the course of the reactivation. Be reminded of your responsibility to ensure that only low risk consignees are tagged in the Green Lane selectivity and report your observations to the Chief, RMO.

Anent to this, you may utilize the personnel assigned at the Entry Processing Units (EPU) of your ports in monitoring the Green Lane activities, pursuant to CMO 23-2019 whereby all Collection District Entry Processing Units (EPU) are designated as Regional Management Units (RMU) and ad interim absorbed as line units under RMO. RMUs as per the above-cited CMO shall function to monitor and ensure feedback on the performance of customs control treatments and interventions on cargo.

Failure in the exercise of this responsibility shall be dealt with accordingly.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to submit to this office on or before June 07, 2019 the list of plantilla holder personnel and non-plantilla personnel currently assigned/designated at EPU in your respective ports for planning and scheduling of RMU related trainings.
