Electronic Form


Starting June 15, 1994, ALL SHIPPING LINES must submit
manifest file through any of the following media: diskette
or by electronic mail in the manner prescribed by CMO No. 6-
93.

Shipping lines which have insufficient IT resources to
comply with the above can avail, for a fee, of a third party
encoding services by arrangement with the Bureau. Interested

Shipments carried by non-complying shipping lines/
agents will not be able to enjoy the full privileges of fast
release via the On-Line Release System (OLRS) and the
