CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER
NO. 10-73

TO: All Collectors of Customs

SUBJECT: Importations of National Power Corporation

Effective immediately, importations of National Power Corporation (NPC) must be cleared thru Customs following the procedures contained herein, as follows:

1) This memorandum order shall be applicable to all shipments of NPC as well as the following projects under the Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) scheme with NPC.

- 1.1. Hopewell Energy Ltd. - 100 MW Gas Turbine Power Plant for Navotas, Metro Manila (BOT)
- 1.2. Enron Power - 105 MW Bunker-C Fired Diesel Thermal Power Plant for Pinamucan, Batangas (BOT)
- 1.3. Olsons/Tomen - 60 MW Diesel Fired Power Plant for Mindanao (BOT); 40 MW Diesel Fired Power Plant for Mindanao (BOT)
- 1.4. First Private Power - 190 MW Bunker-C Fired Diesel Power Plant for Bauang, La Union (BOT)
- 1.5. Polar Energy, Inc. - 3 x 30 MW Barge-mounted bunker fired for Calaca, Batangas.

2) To effect immediate release of the shipments, NPC with its BOT contractors are hereby accredited under the Bureau's Express Processing in the Release of Shipments (CHO 45-88) and entitled to the quick release provided for under said order.

3) The settlement or payment of duties and taxes for the shipments shall be secured by a Certificate of Undertaking to be executed by the Vice President for Finance of NPC. This Certificate of Undertaking shall among others, contain the shipping details of the shipment as appearing in Annex "A" and must contain a statement under oath that as far as the mandate and authority of NPC is concerned, subject shipment is not subject to payment of duties and taxes; but is entitled to subsidies/ exemption or is subject to re-exportation.

4) The Certificate of Undertaking shall initially be presented by NPC or its duly authorized representative to the Collection Service which office, after the usual processing procedures, shall give the necessary instruction (Annex "B") to the Port Collector for the release of the shipment under the said undertaking.

5) All District Collectors and others concerned shall then process the entries pursuant to CMO 45-88 (EPRS) and the instructions issued by the Director, Collection Service.

6) NPC shall within the period specified in the undertaking settle the matter of payment of duties and taxes with the Bureau, Attn.: The Collection Service: After the lapse of the period stated in the undertaking and the promised settlement has not yet been received, the Director, collection Service shall issue a demand letter to NPC for the immediate settlement of the obligation.

Strict compliance to this Order is hereby enjoined.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
