Forwarding the hereto attached letter-reply to Mr. Lyzander Quevada dated October 26, 2021 from the Environmental Management Bureau, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (EMB-DENR) relative to the inquiry on the requirements and procedures to export used hybrid batteries for disposal purposes.

The EMB-DENR informs that the said batteries are classified as hazardous wastes with waste number M506 under Table 2.1 of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2013-22: *Revised Procedures and Standards for the Management of Hazardous Wastes (Revising DAO 2004-36)*.

Thus, the export of the said waste is **regulated**. As such, Export Clearance (EC) from EMB-DENR is required for every shipment of the subject HW.

EC application may be submitted thru [recordsco@emb.gov.ph](mailto:recordsco@emb.gov.ph) and the checklist of requirements for the aforementioned application may be viewed at [emb.gov.ph](http://emb.gov.ph) (Programs – Hazardous Waste Management).
