Attached herewith is the letter dated 31 March 2020 from Secretary William D. Dar, Ph.D., Department of Agriculture (DA) informing this Bureau that all import clearances issued by the Sugar Regulatory Administration shall no longer require a validation and issuance of Certificate of Validity and Authenticity by the Office of the Secretary through the SPS Technical Working Group.

Relative thereto, the following imported commodities were already validated during the DA's Board meetings:

- a. Premix Commodity Release Clearance;
- b. Clearance for Release Imported of Sugar (CBW Food Processors/Manufacturers of Sugar-based Products for Export, Industrial Users, Consumers and End-Users, and Sugar Producers duly registered with the SRA;
- c. Imported Molasses:
- d. High Fructose Corn Syrup (HFCS) and Crystalline Fructose

Thus, a Certificate of Validity and Authenticity shall no longer be issued by the DA to all sugar importers prior to the release of their imported commodities


