SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF SERVICE OF GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE REACHED COMPULSORY RETIREMENT AGE

2. *To ensure transition and turn-over of the work, records, assets, and other pertinent documents of the retiring officials or employees to the next-in-rank or successors."*
