One of the directives given during the recently concluded Collectors Conference last May 17, 2019 is to channel more efforts in tapping non-traditional sources of revenue.

Anent to this, you are hereby directed to immediately dispose seized, abandoned, forfeited and overstaying cargoes. AOCG shall coordinate this bureau wide endeavor, which will form part of our revenue generating measures. At the same time, this will contribute to the prudent utilization of our limited manpower since disposal of these items in our custody would mean personnel assigned in safeguarding these cargoes may be assigned where they are needed the most.

Initially, you are hereby required to conduct an inventory and submit a list of all seized, abandoned, forfeited and overstaying cargoes in your respective ports with corresponding disposal plan and timelines to be submitted to AOCG who in turn will collate and submit the report to this office on or before *27 May 2019, Monday*.

Deputy Commissioner, AOCG may issue subsequent memoranda bearing instructions to effectively carry out this order, copy furnished this office and is further directed to provide status report on the disposal on a weekly basis.

Target date of completion of disposal bureau wide is *first week of July 2019*.
