 Pursuant to Item No. 4.6, Section 4 of Customs Memorandum Order No. 07- 2021 with subject: Updated Guidelines on the Retention/Renewal of Job Order and/or Contract of Service Personnel in the Bureau of Customs, provides for the following:

#### "Section 4. <u>GUIDELINES ON HIRING, RETENTION/RENEWAL OF</u> <u>COS/JO PERSONNEL</u>

4.6 No COS/JO personnel shall assume duties without an approved/signed contract. Any official or employee who permit the reporting of anv individual approved contracts shall be meted with penalty Violation of Reasonable Office Rules and Regulations up to Gross Insubordination in accordance with CMO No. 25-2010 re Bureau of Customs Function-Specific Code of Conduct under Title IV- Offenses and their Corresponding Penalties, to wit:

Offense	Penalty
Violation of Reasonable Office Rules and Regulations	1st Offense – Reprimand
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense – Suspension for one (1) day to thirty (30) days
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense – Dismissal
