SUBJECT: DOF Department Order No. 046-2014 / Further Extension of Application Period for Importers and Customs Brokers with Valid and Existing Accreditation


Attached is a copy of Department Order No. 046-2014 dated June 26, 2014 duly issued by Secretary Cesar V. Purisima, Department of Finance, informing that the extended period set in DO No. 033-2014 dated 21 May 2014 within which to file the applications shall be **further extended until 31 July 2014**, in order to give all importers and customs brokers concerned additional time to prepare and secure their accreditation requirements.

Attention is hereby invited to the second paragraph of Department Order No. 046-2014, which read as follows:

“Failure to file the proper application with the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) and the Bureau of Customs (BOC) by the date stated in the immediately preceding paragraph, and in the manner prescribed by the pertinent rules, shall result in the automatic cancellation of the existing accreditation, if any, **effective 1 August 2014 or the date of expiration as indicated in the original BOC accreditation, whichever is earlier.**”
