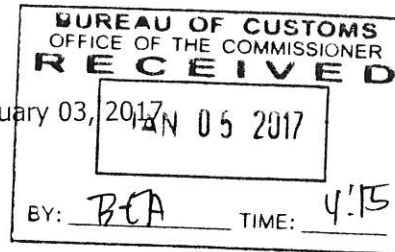




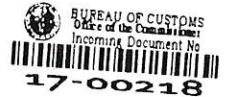

SUBJECT: JAPAN – WORLD CUSTOMS ORGANIZATION (WCO) HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME)



- 1.0 This is to inform that this Bureau is being invited by the World Customs Organization (WCO) relative to Japan – WCO Human Resource Development Programme that will award a number of scholarships for the Master's Degree Programme in Public Finance at the National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS) in Tokyo, Japan which provides a grant covering travel, subsistence, admission, tuition and other approved expenses to enable promising young Customs managers from developing countries.
- 2.0 The major objective of the Public Finance Program is to provide students with the conceptual understanding and technical competence to become leaders in the area of taxation and customs.
- 3.0 The scholarship is for 13 months academic year starting from September 2017 and will finish on September 2018.
