CMTA, RELATIVE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION
AND DISPOSITION OF DULY ISSUED ALERT
ORDERS.

In line with the policy of the Bureau to protect the integrity of the Alert Order System and to avoid unnecessary delay in the implementation and disposition of the same, all concerned BOC officials are hereby reminded to strictly observe the procedures in the implementation of Alert Orders and disposition of alerted shipments as provided for under Items V and VI of CMO No. 35-2015, in relation to Sec. 1111 of the CMTA.

For shipments not properly examined due to non-cooperation of the consignee of record or representative/s acting on its behalf, or for abandoned shipments, concerned BOC officials may now resort to the procedures provided for under Sec. 1129 and Sec. 1130 of the CMTA in order to preserve the value of the abandoned shipments and for its proper disposition in favor of the government.
