MEMORANDUM

RE : Temporary Lifting of Suspension, Cancellation and
Revocation of the Customs Accreditation Privileges of
Importers with Seized and/or Forfeited Shipments

Relative to the directive of this Office in Memorandum dated 31 May 2017, and in order to immediately accommodate the processing of shipments arrived prior to or on the date of suspension, cancellation or revocation of their customs accreditation privileges, concerned importers may submit a letter addressed to this Office asking for the temporary lifting of such suspension, cancellation or revocation. The letter must contain the following:

- 1.) Consignee's name, address and contact number;
- 2.) Bill of Lading number/s (only those provided will be processed);
- 3.) List and the description of the pending shipments;
- 4.) Port of Destination of the subject shipments; and
- 5.) A statement that a motion or letter for reconsideration to permanently lift such suspension, cancellation or revocation has been filed with the Account Management Office.

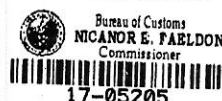
For shipment/s still in transit at the time of the suspension, cancellation or revocation, the importer is advised to submit their letter requests after the said shipment/s have arrived at the port of destination.

The temporary lifting of the suspension, cancellation or revocation, if approved, shall last ten (10) working days from the reactivation of the importer's account or upon release of the subject shipments, *whichever comes first*. Processing of the requests will take one (1) to two (2) days from the receipt of the importer's letter. The AMO will send an electronic mail to the importer concerned once the latter's account has been reactivated.

A request for the temporary lifting of the suspension, cancellation or revocation may only be submitted once. Subsequent requests from the same importer will no longer be entertained by this Office.
