This has reference to the letter from Philippine Ports Authority (PPA) on the non-compliance to PPE of boarding personnel in some ports conducting boarding formalities.

Thus, it is hereby reiterated that BOC personnel conducting boarding formalities, examination of cargoes, and whenever required by port terminal authorities are obliged to wear PPE, such as skull guards/hard hats, high visibility clothing, and other protective equipment, to ensure safety and uniformity in the implementation of port regulations.
