A. Master in International Affairs (MIA)

A two-year full-time programme for professionals with a keen interest in Asian and global affairs and a strong passion to contribute to positive transformations worldwide.

Admission Requirements: Online application form; Official academic transcripts and certificates, curriculum vitae or resume (optional); GRE/GMAT/LSAT test score; personal statement in no more than 500 words; three reports of reference

B. Master in Public Policy (MPP)

A two-year full-time programme for early-career professionals with at least two years of relevant work experience, looking to gain a strong foundation in policy analysis, programme evaluation, and public management.

Admission Requirements: Online application form; Official academic transcripts and certificates; curriculum vitae or resume; A score of 100 (TOEFL internet-based test), 600 (TOEFL paper-based test) or 7.0 (IELTS academic test) is mandatory for all applicants except those with a bachelor degree conducted entirely in English; two essays; two reports of reference - one professional and one academic reference.

C. Master in Public Administration (MPA)

A one-year full-time programme for mid-managerial professionals with at least five years of relevant work experience, seeking to transition to senior management and leadership roles through intensive, interdisciplinary training in decision-making and problem-solving.

Admission Requirements: Online application form; Official academic transcripts and certificates; curriculum vitae or resume; A score of 100 (TOEFL internet-based test), 600 (TOEFL paper-based test) or 7.0 (IELTS academic test) is mandatory for all applicants except those with a bachelor degree conducted entirely in English; GRE/GMAT test score (optional); two essays; two reports of reference.
