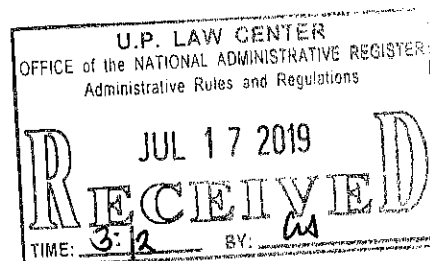



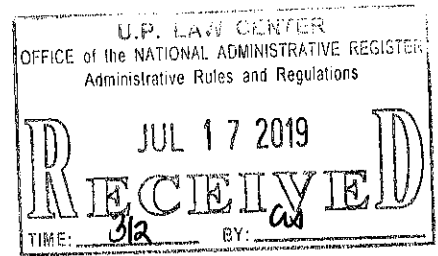

CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER (CMO)

ALL FORMAL ENTRY DIVISION PERSONNEL
ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : OPERATIONAL CONTROL OVER PRINCIPAL APPRAISERS

In line with the full implementation of the National Valuation Verification System (NVVS), the operational control and supervision of all Principal Appraisers is hereby remanded to the District and Sub-port Collectors concerned.

Imports Assessment Service (IAS) shall continue to monitor the regular updating of NVVS values and ensure that it is being implemented/utilized in all ports.

All concerned Customs examiners and appraisers are hereby directed to ascertain the truth or accuracy of any statement, document or declaration presented for customs valuation purposes. Failure to observe correct valuation and assessment of goods shall not be tolerated and shall be dealt with accordingly.

CMO's and Memoranda inconsistent herewith are hereby modified revoked or amended accordingly.
