PLATFORM AS OF SEPTEMBER 2021 OF THE OPTICAL
MEDIA BOARD (OMB)

With reference to the attached letter dated 05 August 2021 from Atty. Christian D. Natividad, Chairman, CEO, OMB, Office of the President (OP) addressed to the Secretary of the Department of Finance (DOF), please be informed that the OMB has been ready to use/using the Tradenet Platform (Tradenet.gov.ph) to process application for License (Accreditation), Import and Export Permit since 13 August 2021.

The following five (5) pilot users will be/has been using the said platform:

- a) Samsung Electronic Philippine Corporation
- b) Acer Philippines Inc.
- c) Yokogawa/Melco
- d) Bordertrade Management Inc. and
- e) Capital One Phils. Support Services Corporation

As to the rest of the stakeholders, the current system of manual processing of License will still be used but will eventually migrate to the Tradenet System in due time.

Moreover, while the License and Permit are in electronic form, it should be noted that this does not preclude the presentation and acceptance of a manually prepared amended permit in cases allowed by the rules.

Please be guided accordingly.

Subject: *USE OF THE TRADENET PLATFORM (tradenet.gov.ph)*

Dear Secretary Dominguez:

This is to respectfully inform your good office that the OPTICAL MEDIA BOARD (OMB) is ready and will now start to use the Tradenet Platform (tradenet.gov.ph) for the pilot implementation of the processing of License (Accreditation), Import and Export Permit on 18 August 2021. Initially, 6x3 (5) pilot users will be using the said platform, namely:

1. Samsung Electronic Philippines Corporation,
2. ACER Philippines Inc.,
3. Yokogawa / MELCO,
4. Bordertrade Management Inc., and
5. Capital One Phils. Support Services Corporation

In the meantime, the rest of the stakeholders will use the current manual procedure and OMB Online Portal for the License (Accreditation) and Permits, but will eventually migrate to the Tradenet System in due time.

Please note that while the pilot implementation of the OMB Importer and Exporter License (Accreditation) will be in automated or electronic form, this does not preclude the presentation and acceptance of a manually prepared amended permit in cases allowed by the rules.

We recognize the important and indispensable role of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) in the claiming and utilization of the aforementioned License (Accreditation) and Permits within the Tradenet System (tradenet.gov.ph). The online, real-time, and immutable nature of the feedback regarding the said claiming and utilization will provide the OMB with a more efficient way to monitor and document the usage of the said permits.
