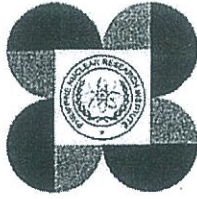
The following five (5) pilot users will be/has been using the said platform:

- e) Ibiden Philippines

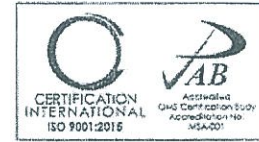
As to the rest of the stakeholders, the current system of manual processing of Certificates will still be used but will eventually migrate to the Tradenet System in due time.

**Dear Secretary Dominguez:**

This is to respectfully inform your good office that the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute is ready and will now start to use the Tradenet Platform (Tradenet.gov.ph) to process the Certificate of Release, Certificate of Exemption for Import and Certificate of Exemption for Export of commodities.

Initially, five (5) users from our roster of commercial licensees will be using the said platform, namely:
