4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"BOSPHORE" HPV HR-LR GENOTYPING KIT V1"

Based on the user manual, safety data sheet, production workflow chart, and photograph of actual product submitted, subject article is an *in vitro* diagnostic kit used for the detection and characterization of the genotype of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV), encompassing high risk and low risk groups of HPV genotypes, in human biological samples (such as swab, tissue, biopsy specimen, serum, and plasma). Based on the Real-Time Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) technique, fluorescence detection of the virus is accomplished using FAM, HEX, Texas RED, and Cy5 filters. Subject article has the following specifications:

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 38.22 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, diagnostic or laboratory reagents on a backing, prepared diagnostic or laboratory reagents whether or not on a backing, whether or not put up in the form of kits, other than those of heading 30.06. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that reagents of this heading are either on a backing or in the form of preparations and thus comprise more than a single constituent. For example, they may consist of admixtures of two or more reagents or of single reagents dissolved in solvents other than water. They may also be in the form of paper, plastics or other materials (used as backings or support), impregnated or coated with one or more diagnostic or laboratory reagents, such as litmus, pH or pole-finding papers or pre-coated immuno-assay plates. Reagents of this heading may also be put up in the form of kits, consisting of several components, even if one or more components are separate chemically defined compounds of Chapter 28 or Chapter 29, synthetic colouring matter of heading 32.04 or any other substance which, when presented separately, would be classifiable under another heading. Examples of such kits are those for testing glucose in blood, ketones in urine, etc., and those based on enzymes.

The reagents of this heading should be clearly identifiable as being for use only as diagnostic or laboratory reagents. This must be clear from their composition, labelling, instructions for *in vitro* or laboratory use, indication of the specific diagnostic test to be performed or physical form (e.g., presented on a backing or support).

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3822.19.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"DXN ALOE. V HYDRATING MASK"

Based on the product ingredient declaration, product information sheet, manufacturing process flowchart, finished goods specification, and photograph of product submitted, subject article is a wash-off facial mask in the form of a transparent light-blue gel. It is formulated with sodium hyaluronate, water, butylene glycol, methyl gluceth-20, malachite and Aloe barbadensis extracts, and fragrance, among others. Packed in 100-g plastic tubes, subject article is applied to thoroughly cleansed skin (avoiding the eye area) then rinsed off with water after three minutes. It is to be used twice a week on dry skin or once a week on normal or oily skin to hydrate and restore skin radiance.



REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 33.04 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, beauty or make-up preparations and preparations for the care of the skin (other than medicaments), including sunscreen or sun tan preparations. The Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this part covers, among others, other beauty or make-up preparations and preparations for the care of the skin (other than medicaments), such as, beauty creams, cold creams, make-up creams, cleansing creams, skin foods (including those containing bees' royal jelly) and skin tonics or body lotions.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3304.99.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"LIVER PATE ST 7005/22"

Based on the technical data sheet, certificate of analysis, packaging specification, ingredient listing, process flow diagram, and sample submitted, subject article is a flavouring preparation composed of odoriferous substances (nutmeg oil and pimento berry oil mixture) with palm oil, nature-identical flavouring substances, BHA 320, and smoke flavourings. It is in the form of a yellowish, oily liquid with a meaty-roasted aroma. Packed in 25-kg high-density polyethylene (HDPE) jerry cans, subject article is used as an ingredient in sauces (pasteurized, sterilized, or UHT) and other savory applications and is added at an inclusion rate of 0.05 to 0.2%.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 33.02 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, mixtures of odoriferous substances and mixtures (including alcoholic solutions) with a basis of one or more of these substances, of a kind used as raw materials in industry. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers the following mixtures provided they are of a kind used as raw materials in the perfumery, food or drink industries (e.g., in confectionery, food or drink flavourings) or in other industries (e.g., soap-extracted oleoresins or synthetic aromatics) combined with added diluents or carriers such as vegetable oil, dextrose or starch.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3302.10.30, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"GANOZHI® TOOTHPASTE"

Based on the product ingredient declaration, product information sheet, manufacturing process flowchart, finished goods specification, and photograph of product submitted, subject article is a toothpaste in the form of a light-brown gel. It contains dicalcium phosphate, aqua, sucrose, glycerin, algin, menthol, *Ganoderma lucidum* extract, *Mentha piperita* oil, and sodium lauryl sulfate. Packed in 75-g or 150-g tubes, subject article is used to clean teeth and freshen breath.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 33.06 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, preparations for oral or dental hygiene, including denture fixative pastes and powders. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers preparations for oral or dental hygiene such as, among others, dentifrices of all types including toothpastes and other preparations for teeth. These are substances or preparations used with a toothbrush, whether for cleaning or polishing the accessible surfaces of teeth or for other purposes such as anticaries prophylactic treatment. Toothpastes and other preparations for teeth remain classified in this heading, whether or not they contain abrasives and whether or not they are used by dentists.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3306.10.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
