



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"OTTERBOX ALL DAY BAND"

Based on the product specifications and sample submitted, subject article is a wristwatch strap made of silicone and fitted with stainless steel buckle and buckle tongue. It has dimensions of 22.19 cm \times 3.44 cm \times 0.30 cm and 21.44 cm \times 3.20 cm \times 0.30 cm (LxWxT). Contained in a paperboard retail packaging, subject article is available in various colors and is intended for Apple Watch Series 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 smartwatches.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 91.13 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers watch straps, watch bands and watch bracelets, and parts thereof. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers all kinds of watch straps, watch bands and watch bracelets, i.e., all devices for fastening watches to the wrist. Watch straps, watch bands and watch bracelets may be of any material, for example, base metal, precious metal, leather, plastics or textile material. They may also be clearly decorative in character without this affecting their classification.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 9113.90.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem and ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "E".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"DXN® GANOZHI BODY FOAM"

Based on the product ingredient declaration, product information sheet, manufacturing process flowchart, finished goods specifications, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a mild cleansing body foam in the form of a brownish concentrated liquid. It is formulated with cocamidopropyl betaine and sodium laureth sulfate (surfactants), water, cocamide diethanolamine, lanolin, glycerin, and *Ganoderma lucidum* (mushroom) extract, among others. Available in 250-mL bottles and 8-mL sachets, subject article is applied and lathered over the body then rinsed off thoroughly.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 34.01 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, organic surface-active products and preparations for washing the skin, in the form of liquid or cream and put up for retail sale, whether or not containing soap. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this part includes preparations for washing the skin, in which the active component consists wholly or partly of synthetic organic surface-active agents (which may contain soap in any proportion), provided they are in the form of liquid or cream and put up for retail sale.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3401.30.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 10% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"MINI OREO ORIGINAL"

Based on the product composition, manufacturing process flowchart, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a chocolate sandwich cookie with vanilla-flavoured filling. It is made from flour, sugar, non-hydrogenated vegetable oil, high fructose syrup, cocoa powder, corn starch, soy lecithin, and vanillin flavour, among others. Subject article is packed in cartons containing 10 pieces of 20.4-g foil packs.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 19.05 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, bread, pastry, cakes, biscuits and other bakers' wares, whether or not containing cocoa. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the heading includes, among others, biscuits. These are usually made from flour and fat to which may have been added sugar or certain of the substances. They are baked for a long time to improve the keeping qualities and are generally put up in closed packages. There are various types of biscuits including, among others, sweet biscuits, which are fine bakers' wares with long-keeping qualities and a base of flour, sugar or other sweetening matter and fat (these ingredients constituting at least 50% of the product by weight), whether or not containing added salt, almonds, hazelnuts, flavouring, chocolate, coffee, etc. The water content of the finished product must be 12% or less by weight and the maximum fat content 35% by weight (fillings and coatings are not to be taken into consideration in determining these contents). Commercial biscuits are not usually filled, but they may sometimes contain a solid or other filling (sugar, vegetable fat, chocolate, etc.). They are almost always industrially manufactured products.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 1905.31.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 15% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
