

It is in the form of white pellets, with a melt flow index of 1.0 g/10 minutes at 190°C and a density of 0.918 g/cm³. Pácked in 25-kg plastic bags, subject article is used in the manufacture of shipping sacks, liners, ice and frozen food bags, and stretch wrap films, among others.


