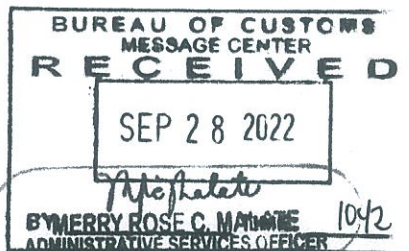

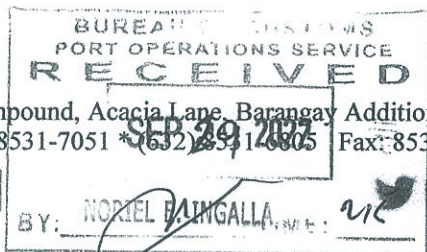
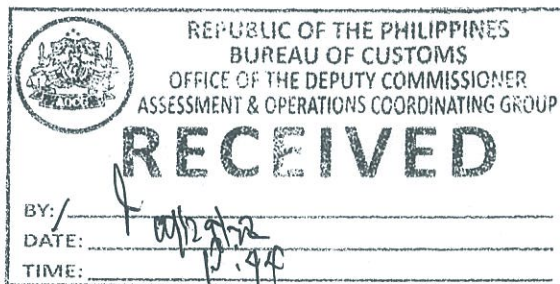
We hope that you would extend a helping hand by way of donating for the POPCOM- Central Office and to its 16 Regional Offices nationwide.
