SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF DATA ON OIL IMPORTATIONS

DATE : December 13, 2022

On the occasion of the visit and ocular inspection of the Ways and Means Committee of the Senate of the Philippines at the main office of the Bureau of Customs, Senator Joseph Victor G. Ejercito discussed that there are oil companies who are selling their products at a cheaper price suggesting that they are not paying the correct duties and taxes.

In this regard, all ports are hereby directed to submit data on oil importation in your respective ports vis-à-vis the Department of Energy import advice and the Load Port Survey Report (LPSR) and/or Discharge Port Survey Report (DPSR) covering each shipment.

Further, the Collection Districts are instructed to furnish the data to the Office of the Director, Port Operations Service (POS) through [pocd@customs.gov.ph](mailto:pocd@customs.gov.ph) and [odc.aocg@customs.gov.ph](mailto:odc.aocg@customs.gov.ph) every Monday observing the herein provided template.

In this connection, the Port Operations Service (POS) is strictly mandated to monitor and study the reports by the Ports.
