#### Refers to:

✓ Importer, exporter, customs broker, freightforwarder, forwarder, transport provider, and any other entity

✓ Duly accredited by the Bureau of Customs based on the World Customs Organization (WCO) Framework of Standards to Secure and Facilitate Global Trade, the Revised Kyoto Convention (RKC), the WCO Supply Chain ManagementGuidelines and the various national best practices

 To promote trade facilitation and to a seamless provide movement of goods across borders through secure international trade supply chains with the use of riskmanagement and modern technology.

## **Who May Apply?**

**Pursuant to Customs Memorandum Order** (CMO) 9-2020, the implementation of the AEO Program shall only cover Importers roll-out **Exporters**. The of and implementation of AEO for other stakeholders shall be upon the issuance of subsequent regulations.
