OPERATED BY PHILIPPINE SKYLANDERS, INC.,
PHILIPPINE AIRLINES, PAIRCARGO, DELBROS,
CARGOHAUS (FORMERLY U-WAREHOUSE), DHL
PHILIPPINES AND MIASCOR LOGISTICS RESPECTIVELY
NAIA COMPLEX.

By authority of Section 608 in relation to Section 1909 of the Tariff and Customs. Code of the Philippines, as amended, and in line with the Bureau's effort to standardize various charges for operations affecting imported cargoes before actual delivery to the importer/consignee, and taking into account the present economic condition and facilities given by these CBW operators, the service, storage and other charges on articles/merchandise stored at the Philippine Skylanders, Inc., Philippine Agrlines, PAIRCARGO, Delbros, Cargohaus (formerly U-Warehouse), DHL Philippine's and Miascor Logistics all Customs Public Bonded Warehouse shall be governed by the following rules:

IV. CLASSIFICATION OF CARGOES

A. General Cargo

All cargoes not included in the above enumeration of special cargo, each kind, class or nature is described hereinbelow,

B. Special Cargo

- Baggage and Personal Effects kinds of shipments that are handled with special care and provided special storage locations.
- Perishables shipments shown as such on the Cargo Manifest (CM) and Air Waybill (AWB) or labelled/identified on the package/s as such, hence requiring storage under specified temperatures. (All aquatic products fall under this classification).
- Valuable Cargo shipments shown on the CM and/or AWB as such or so labelled/identified on the package/s pursuant to IATA regulations.
