CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER
No. 6-91

To: ALL COLLECTORS OF CUSTOMS
AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

Upon the request of Executive Director Manuel M. Supnet of the Dangerous Drugs Board, you are hereby directed -

1. To withhold the release of importation of drugs unless cleared by the Executive Director, Dangerous Drugs Board.
2. To remind customs examiners to only get reasonable quantity of drugs to be used as samples for laboratory/testing purposes. For this purpose, reasonable quantity shall mean -
 - 2.1 In case of vials - from one (1) to two (2) samples only and
 - 2.2. In case of powder or in tablet form - from ten (10) to twenty (20) grams only.

Additionally, the other requirements relative to the getting of samples embodied in CMO No. 8-89 are hereby reiterated.

Non-compliance with the directive of this CMO shall be dealt with accordingly.

This Order takes effect immediately.
