CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER No. 6 - 91

To: ALL COLLECTORS OF CUSTOMS AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

Upon the request of Executive Director Manuel M. Supnet of the Dangerous Drugs Board, you are hereby directed -

- 1. To withhold the release of importation of drugs unless cleared by the Executive Director, Dangerous Drugs Board.
- 2. To remind customs examiners to only get reasonable quantity of drugs to be used as samples for laboratory/testing purposes. For this purpose, reasonable quantity shall mean -
 - 2.1 In case of vials from one (1) to two (2) samples only and
 - 2.2. In case of powder or in tablet form from ten (10) to twenty (20) grams only.

Additionaly, the other requirements relative to the getting of samples embodied in CMO No. 8-89 are hereby reiterated.

Non-compliance with the directive of this CMO shall be dealt with accordingly.

This Order takes effect immediately.
