CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 34-97

SUBJECT: USE OF ADVANCED AND/OR FAX COPIES OF AWB'S FOR PROCESSING WAREHOUSING ENTRIES OF SEMICONDUCTOR INDUSTRIES AT NAIA CUSTOMHOUSE

1.0 OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 To expedite the processing of warehousing enteries of semiconductor industries
- 1.2 To assist the semiconductor industries

2.0 SCOPE

This order shall apply to shipments consigned to companies which are members of Semiconductor Electronics Industries Foundation, Inc. (SEIFI) to be processed under warehousing entries.

3.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 3.1 NAIA Customhouse may allow the processing of shipments covered by this Order on the basis of advanced and/or fax copies of airway bills (AWB's) provided the following requirements are complied with:
 - 3.1.1 The consignee is a company which is a member of SEIFI and not an individual who may be an officer of that company.
 - The Customs broker processing the warehousing entries is duly registered and authorized by the consignee to process its warehousing entry. For this purpose, the consignee shall provide the NAIA Customhouse with the most current list of its

Customs brokers or brokerage compnaies duly authorized by ther former to process it entries under this Order while the latter shall likewise provide their updated list of duly authorized representatives with their 2x2 photographs and specimen signatures for dissemination to all public bonded warehouses and/or CY-CFS at the NAIA Customhouse.

- the broker have executed The consignee and 3.1.3 Certification and/or Undertaking stating among others, that they hold the Collector of Customs and/or any of its agents free and harmless from any liability in case of misdelivery of the shipment, and shall assume such liability imposed upon the Collector of Customs under Section 1501 and 1502 of the Tariff and Customs Code of the Philippines, as amended. The said certification and/or undertaking shall be applied for the current year shipments unless sooner invalidated for the rest of the year shipments with approval by the NAIA District Collector of Customs. A format of the said certification and/or undertaking is hereto attached as Annex A.
- The consignee/broker shall devise a system with the airline and 3.2 consolidator/forwarder so that the latter's airline charges are settled accordingly. If necessary, they are encouraged to enter into an agreement with each other and with the warehouse operator to guarantee the payment of such charges.

4.0 REPEALING CLAUSE

All rules and regulations inconsistent with this Order are hereby deemed repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

5.0 EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect on 3 November 1997.
