CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER No: 8-95

SUBJECT : Amendments to Customs Memorandum Order No. 62-93 (TRANSSHIPMENT OF CIGARETTES)

The following amendments and modifications to provisions of CMO No. 62-93 as herein specified hereby made:

" X X X

" 3. As a general rule, foreign transshipment of cigarettes with significant domestic consumption such as the brands hereunder specified shall not be allowed, except when they are to be entered/discharged and then shipped back to the port of final destination (foreign) directly from the Port of Manila (South Harbor) and the Manila International Container Port (MICP):

1. MARLBORO

2. WINSTON

3. CHAMPION

4. SALEM

5. KENT

6. DUNHILL 7. BENSON & HEDGES

In all cases, the approving authority must ALERT the Bureau's law enforcement units accordingly, provide the Philippine Navy headquarters the schedule of departure and sailing plan of the carrying vessel submitted by the enforcement units the shipping agent. Customs may conduct monitoring and surveillance operations without, however, causing undue delay in the processing of the application transshipment.

" X X X

5. The shipping company/agent who applied for transshipment of such cargo shall, within FIFTEEN (15) days from the departure of the carrying vessel, submit a Certificate of Landing issued by competent customs officers at the port of final destination."

All other customs issuances which are inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked or modified accordingly.

This order shall take effect immediately.
