CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 34-92

TO: All Service Chiefs

All Collectors of Customs

All Division Chiefs

All Others Concerned

## SUBJECT: Delegation of Signing/Approving Authority

Further to CMO 68-91, the authority to act, on matters listed hereinbelow is hereby delegated to the Officials concerned as indicated, in order to ensure expedient action thereon, viz:

A. Deputy Commissioner for Internal Administration

Amount involved shall be from \$100,000.00 to \$1,000,000.00

- A.1 Construction and repair/renovation of building:
- A.2 Acquisition of office equipment and furniture;
- A.3 Acquisition of office supplies; and
- A.4 Service contract/consultancy.

However, all subject matters of a contract involving an amount of more than FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000.00) PESOS shall first be approved by the Commissioner as a proposal before a formal contract can be entered into by the Deputy Commissioner for Internal Administration.

- District Collector of Customs/Sub-port Collector of Customs Amount involved below \$100,000.00
  - B.1 Repair/renovation of office buildings;
  - B.2 Acquisition of office equipment and furniture;
  - B.3 Acquisition of office supplies; and
  - B.4 Service contract/consultancy.

However, where the amount involved is more than \$50,000.00. the Collector of Customs shall first secure the conformity of the District Collector of Customs.

C. Contracts involving the amount of ONE MILLION (\$1,000,000.00) PESOS or more shall be signed by the Commissioner of Customs upon the recommendation of a Bidding Committee which shall have the following composition:

Deputy Commissioner for Internal
Administration - - - - - - - Chairman

Service Chief, Legal Service - - - Member

Collector of Customs of the
Port Concerned - - - - - - Member

Representative, Office of
the Commissioner - - - - - Member

COA Representative - - - - - - Member

This Order shall take effect on March 16, 1992.

All previous orders inconsistent hereto are hereby revoked/revised/amended accordingly.
